Re: Creditable Coverage Confirmation

Medicare regulations require employers that provide prescription drug coverage through a group sponsored health plan to disclose to their Medicare eligible employees (and retirees in some cases) whether or not their prescription drug coverage is “creditable.”

Coverage is defined as creditable when its actuarial value equals or exceeds the standard Part D prescription drug benefit. In general, the actuarial value of the benefit is determined by whether or not the prescription drug coverage is expected to pay out, on average for all participants, at least as much as the standard part D coverage would pay in calendar year 2006. If the coverage does not equal or exceed the value of the standard Part D benefit, it is considered “non-creditable.”

This letter confirms that Health Net has conducted the gross value test for the current Rx Plan (HN Group #) and has determined that your Plan does meet or exceed the actuarial value of the standard Part D benefit, and is therefore considered “Creditable”.

Note: Employers are required to disclose the creditable status of their pharmacy plans to Medicare eligible employees (and retirees in some cases).
